Skills Focus: Techniques for Recycling Ideas - Turning the Old into Something New

Recycling ideas is a powerful way to stay innovative and adaptable. Instead of discarding old thoughts, skills, or methods, you can repurpose, reshape, and refine them to fit new situations. Here are five key techniques to help you refresh ideas and bring them to life in creative ways:

1 The Remix Technique

Take an existing idea and combine it with something new.

Example: Podcasts + Al → Al-generated storytelling podcasts

How to Apply: Look at successful ideas in different industries and blend them in a unique way.

2 The Reverse Thinking Method

- Flip a concept upside down to find a fresh perspective.
- ✓ Example: Instead of selling products, offer rental subscriptions (e.g., clothing rental services).
- ✓ How to Apply: Ask yourself, "What if I did the opposite?" or "How would this idea work in reverse?"

3 The Subtraction Approach

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- Simplify an idea by removing unnecessary elements.
- ✓ Example: Twitter simplified blogging by limiting posts to 280 characters → Microblogging was born.
- ✔ How to Apply: Look at something complex and ask, "What can I remove to make this idea more efficient?"

4 The Adaptation Strategy

- Take an idea from one field and apply it to another.
- ✓ Example: Gamification (originally from video games) is now used in education, fitness apps, and employee training.
- ✓ How to Apply: Ask, "Where else can this idea be useful?" and adjust it for a new audience.

5 The Mashup Method

- Combine two unrelated ideas to create something new.
- ✓ Example: Music + AI → AI-powered music composition software
- ✔ How to Apply: Take two random concepts and brainstorm how they could work together.

At just 19 years old, Toby Roberts proved that passion and perseverance can lead to greatness. His journey to becoming an Olympic gold medalist in men's boulder and lead climbing at Paris 2024 was far from easy.

Toby discovered climbing at age 12, quickly falling in love with the sport. However, the path to the top was filled with setbacks and challenges. During his early years, he struggled to find proper



training facilities and faced tough competition from more experienced climbers. But instead of giving up, he turned obstacles into opportunities, training relentlessly, even on a homemade climbing wall built by his father during the lockdown.

As he entered professional competitions, he experienced defeats and near misses, but each setback fueled his determination. His resilience paid off when he dominated the Paris 2024 Olympics, showcasing his incredible strength, strategy, and mental toughness to claim the gold medal.

Toby's story is a powerful reminder that success isn't about having the perfect start—it's about staying committed, thinking creatively, and pushing forward no matter the challenges.
